







## Step 1: Choosing a Name

- Check Name Availability: Ensure your desired name is available in Texas [View Here].
- ¬ Name Requirements: Comply with Texas naming regulations for LLCs.
- Trade Name (DBA): If operating under a different name, file an assumed name certificate.

### Step 2: Appointing a Registered Agent

- Delect a Registered Agent: Choose a Registered Agent with a physical Texas address.
- Registered Agent Consent: Obtain consent from the designated Registered Agent.

### Step 3: Filing the Certificate of Formation

- Prepare the Certificate: Complete the Texas Certificate of Formation (Form 205) [View Form 205 Here].
- $\Box$  **File with the SOS:** File the certificate with the Texas Secretary of State.
- □ Filing Fee: Pay the required filing fee.

## Step 4: Creating an Operating Agreement

- Draft the Agreement: Create a comprehensive operating agreement outlining member responsibilities and profit/loss distribution.
- Member Agreement: Ensure all members agree to and sign the operating agreement.

# Step 5: Obtaining an EIN (Employer Identification Number)

Apply for an EIN: Apply for an EIN from the IRS [Apply Here] (if required).

# **Step 6: Texas Franchise Tax**

- $\Box$  Review Obligations: Understand Texas Franchise Tax requirements [View Here].
- $\Box$  **File Reports:** File required reports and pay **Franchise Tax**, if applicable.
